Experience thrilling whitewater stretches between mild riffles, placid pools, and narrow canyons edged by towering cliffs in this remarkable 30-mile stretch of the Rogue that runs from Grave Creek to Foster Bar. Old growth Douglas firs and other deciduous trees create a perfect river bank habitat for the abundant wildlife of the Rogue River Canyon that include otters and beavers, deer and Roosevelt elk, black bears, cougars, osprey, bald eagles and many more.

Our rafts, paddle rafts, and inflatable kayaks are all available for your enjoyment on our Wild Section trips. The whitewater on this section is rated Class III-IV, with two world famous Class IV+ rapids: Blossom Bar Rapid and Mule Creek Canyon.

## Fishing

Rogue Wilderness has specialized in Salmon and Steelhead fishing on the Rogue River since the early 1970s. Our seasoned guides are experts in a variety of fishing techniques, including spin casting, bait bouncing, pulling plugs, and fly fishing.

To provide individual instruction, we designate one guide per two anglers in each boat. Our McKenzie-style drift boats are truly the "Rolls Royce" of river craft. Passengers relax in the luxury of comfortable bucket-type seats with back rests while they await their catch. The guide sits behind the guests to offer instruction and watch rod tips for the tell-tale bite. Fishing rods and tackle, bait and flies are all furnished by the guides on this trip.

### SINGLE-DAY FISHING

Rogue Wilderness is based just downriver from Grants Pass, Oregon in the town of Merlin. Merlin has easy access to over 54 miles of the Rogue River where there is excellent fishing for the day. Day trips available May thru June, and then September thru October.



### MULTI-DAY FISHING

Our most popular multiple day fishing trips begin in late summer with our famous Rogue River Canyon trips; here anglers enjoy the solitude of wilderness fishing coupled with spectacular scenery, thrilling white water, and short-sleeve weather. This combination makes for a fantastic fishing experience.

Trips are three or four days and cover between 36 and 56 river miles. Midday is spent on shore where a tasty buffet is prepared by our guides, who double as chefs experienced in the art of riverbank cooking. Fresh steelhead is skinned and smoked with the leaves of nearby alder trees; next the fish is grilled over an open fire for a not-to-be forgotten taste bud delight.

As the light of day fades, anglers arrive at one of our wilderness lodges. The friendly staff prepares a delicious, family-style meal with all the home cooked goodness of days gone by. Anglers relax in the rustic seclusion of a wilderness lodge and enjoy the comforts of home. The lodges feature double occupancy cabins with private baths.

\*Recommended Trip is the Four Day Fishing Trip. Anglers will see close to 60 miles of beautiful river and enjoy three nights at unique wilderness lodges. Lodges for fishing are: Black Bar, Paradise and Lucas Lodge.

#### CORPORATE/GROUP TRIPS

### Rogue River Fish Guide

**FALL CHINOOK AND COHO SALMON**  
In recent years, the number of fall run Chinook and Coho salmon has increased dramatically, providing an excellent fishery from late August through mid-November.

**SPRING CHINOOK**  
There is probably no better fighting or eating fish than the spring Chinook salmon. "Springers" enter from the ocean to the river from mid-April until the end of July.

**SUMMER RUN STEELHEAD**  
The summer-run steelhead begins to arrive in July through the fall. These beautiful, hard fighting fish are taken on flies and lures. In late August, the famous Rogue "half-pounders" begin their ascent from the ocean. These 14 to 20-inch fish are great fun on light fly rods and spinning equipment.

**WINTER RUN STEELHEAD**  
The large winter steelhead enter Southern Oregon rivers in January, and fishing continues until April. This is an excellent fishing opportunity for the serious fisherman. There are fewer boats, fewer people, and plenty of fish.

## Hiking Trips

### WILD AND SCENIC ROGUE RIVER HIKING TRIPS

Originally built for pack mules supplying miners in the Rogue River Canyon, the Rogue River Trail is over 100 years old and has become one of the greatest historical trails in the country. With our raft supported trips, hikers meet up with their support raft and guide three times a day to replenish water, recharge with a great lunch, and receive trail tips and highlights. Using this support, hikers have the luxury of exploring the trail with a daypack, water, camera and a snack. Each evening, guests stay at one of the historic lodges where they will enjoy comfortable cabins, hot water, private bathrooms and fun dinner conversations with other guests.

Hiking trips are available in May and June, September and October. Mid-summer months are too hot to hike this trail. Our trips begin at Grave Creek trailhead about 30 miles west of the town of Grants Pass, where the elevation is 689 feet. This trip will take 4 days and 3 nights.

In addition to our regular four day hiking trips, we also offer specialty trips, including a hiking and wine tasting trip, a hiking and beer tasting trip, and others. Please contact our office at 1-800-336-1647 or visit our website to see specialty trips that may be available.

**APPELATE WINE TRAIL**  
Tour the beautiful Applegate Valley, just outside Grants Pass, while sampling locally crafted, award-winning wines. The hotter climate of the Applegate and Rogue Valleys creates the perfect conditions for savory cabernets and robust merlots.

**REDWOOD FOREST**
